PUBLIC HEALTH ORDER 2020 (COVID-19) COMPLIANCE

Members are again requested that when visiting the clubhouse to download and use the **Service NSW APP** and to log on and off when entering and leaving the clubhouse, using the QR code provided.

It is reasonably easy to download the Service NSW App and it is the best way to ensure that your contact details are held by Service NSW and not provided to outside sources. It also saves a lot of work behind the scenes for our limited number of volunteers.

If members are unable to use the QR code system (we trust this is almost no one), then there is a need to clearly enter the member number (**the correct one**) and Name on the sign-in sheet, you **do not** have to enter a mobile number.

Perhaps members are unaware of the procedure required when members do not utilise the QR App system. Someone within the office is required to convert the manual names sheet to a digital spreadsheet within 12 hours, which is required to be readily available for the **Health Department** should they request it.

Last Saturday, 68 members manually signed in with several even using incorrect "**member number**", **some no member number at all, postcode for member number, and of course illegible handwriting**. We urgently request your assistance in using the QR code method which promises to be around for a long time.

MESSAGE FROM THE TREASURER - In order to minimise the use of cash at the bar, members are reminded that the preferred method of payment is Bar Credit or Eftpos.

Bar Credit can be topped up at any time by visiting the office.


