

# **COVID-19 Safety Plan**

## **for Members in RVGC Golf Competitions**

### **from 5:00pm 9 July 2021**

**If you have known or suspected coronavirus or ANY cold or flu like symptoms you CANNOT attend the golf course and play in the Club's competitions.**

- For Club competitions there are no walk up starts, bookings are essential prior to entering the golf course. Contact the Pro Shop to see if there are any cancellations that would create a tee time to book.
- **Members who live in the Wollongong Local Government Area are only permitted to play in the competition and no carpooling between non-household persons when travelling to the course. Members must provide proof of residency at the Pro Shop before teeing off.**
- Do not arrive until 10 minutes before your tee time, time spent at the course should be limited to warm up, followed by competition play only.
- **There will only be two players in each group.**
- **Players must register in on the Pro Shop's QR code.**
- **Face masks must be used if unable to maintain social distances.**
- The Pro Shop would prefer that all fees are to be paid by debit or credit card.
- **Golf carts allowed on the course, but only one person in each cart.**
- The golf holes are set up so that the ball will be able to be removed from the hole without touching the flagstick. DO NOT alter the hole in any way.



- Players MUST NOT touch the flagstick at any time.
- Preferred lies in Bunkers as there are no rakes, smooth sand with foot or club.
- All play will be mostly individual games.
- Players to remain at least 1.5 to 2 metres from their playing partners and do not stand closely together on tees or greens.
- Players must adhere to all directions from the COVID Marshall.
- Members are to mark their own cards and do not need to get a marker to sign off at end of round.
- Members should check their score with a designated playing companion at the end of each hole and record their and their playing companion's score on their card.
- Cards should have both the numbers and OMR sections completed.
- Cards that are not fully completed with both numbers and OMR sections recorded will not be accepted by the Match & Handicap Committee.
- Members to sign their own card at end of round. Only one signature is required.
- Score card to be placed in the box at the Golf Club Office.
- Members must leave the golf course immediately on completion of their round and submission of their score card.
