COVID-19 Restrictions: Last week the NSW Government announced that the current COVID-19 restrictions will continue through to the end of September 2021. During this time the Clubhouse will remain closed, but competition golf continues under the special COVID Safety Plan.

Earlier this month the Club, through submissions to Wollongong City Council, was able to get additional tee times for the Tuesday and Thursday competitions, with the last tee time now @ 12 mid-day.

Also, online tee bookings have now reverted back to opening @ 7:00pm on the day a week before the competition day.

2021 Annual General Meeting (AGM) – Re-scheduled: Following the NSW Government announcement that the current COVID-19 restrictions will continue to the end of September 2021, the Board has resolved that the 2021 AGM will be re-scheduled to Sunday 21 November @ 11:30am. The revised Notice of the meeting will be issued next week and posted on the website.

Clubhouse Refurbishment: While awaiting the outcome of the Club's application for funding under the NSW Government's 2021 Clubgrants – Infrastructure Grants Program, earlier this month the Board resolved to proceed with some works around the Clubhouse. The men's toilets in the Sports Bar have been re-painted and new flooring installed. Quotes are being obtained for the Sports Bar roof replacement and plans are underway to improve the front entrance to the Clubhouse.

So, continue to remain COVID-19 aware, enjoy your outdoor exercise on the golf course and stay safe during this COVID-19 restrictions period.
