



COVID-19 Safety Plan - Revised

for Members in RVGC Golf Competitions

- Effective from 23 October 2021

If you have known or suspected coronavirus or ANY cold or flu like symptoms you CANNOT attend the golf course and play in the Club's competitions.

- For Club competitions there are no walk up starts, bookings are essential prior to entering the golf course. Contact the Pro Shop to see if there are any cancellations that would create a tee time to book.
- **For Russell Vale Golf Club competitions: fully vaccinated* members can play in groups of four, all other members must play in groups of two. Players must have their proof of vaccination with them at all times.**
- Do not arrive until 10 minutes before your tee time, time spent at the course should be limited to warm up, followed by competition play only.
- **Players must register-in on the Pro Shop's QR code.**
- **Face masks must be worn in the Pro Shop.**
- The Pro Shop would prefer that all fees are to be paid by debit or credit card.
- Golf carts allowed on the course, fully vaccinated persons can share a cart, for others only one person in a cart.

- All play will be mostly individual games.
- Players to remain at least 1.5 to 2 metres from their playing partners and do not stand closely together on tees or greens.
- Players must adhere to all directions from the COVID Marshall.
- Fully vaccinated persons can enter the Clubhouse, face masks must be worn, except when eating or drinking.

Note: From 23 October 2021, members are reminded to swap score cards with their playing partner at the start of the round and mark and sign the score cards as per the *Rules of Golf*.

(***Fully Vaccinated** means you have had 2 doses of an approved COVID-19 vaccination or have a medical contraindication certificate issued to you.)
